The role involves close coordination with communities, local institutions, and project teams to ensure effective delivery of project objectives, with a strong focus on capacity building, entrepreneurship development, and strengthening collective enterprises including Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs).

Key Expectations:

- Lead end-to-end implementation of project activities across different parts of the district in line with approved plans and timelines.
- Work closely with community institutions, farmer groups, women collectives, and local stakeholders to achieve project outcomes.
- Design, coordinate, and facilitate capacity-building initiatives including training programs on livelihoods, entrepreneurship development, and enterprise management.
- Support the formation, establishment, and strengthening of collective enterprises, including Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs), SHG federations, or producer groups.
- Provide handholding support to FPOs/collectives on governance, business planning, aggregation, value addition, and market linkages.
- Ensure timely and effective execution of all project activities and troubleshoot field-level implementation challenges.
- Oversee proper utilization of project budgets and ensure compliance with financial and operational guidelines.
- Monitor project progress, track outputs and outcomes, and ensure quality implementation on the ground.
